What is included in the package?

- Reproductive and fertility assessment (1st cycle)
- Clitoral Contagious Equine Metritis (CEM) swab and lab fees (1st cycle)
- Up to 1 weeks grass livery (1st & 2nd cycle)
- Regular scanning to pin point the optimum time for insemination
- Insemination with a vet and nurse
- Frozen semen storage and handling
- Ovulation induction injections to assist with timing of ovulation/insemination
- Oxytocin and post-insemination wash outs
- Pregnancy diagnosis scan at 14 & 28 day post ovulation
- Twin reduction up to 16 days post insemination
- Night-time checks by qualified staff
- Regular phone calls to keep you informed on your mares progress
- Daily feed balancer

ALL MARES MUST HAVE A NEGATIVE STRANGLES SEROLOGY BEFORE ARRIVAL.

WHEN TO BRING YOUR MARE:

Mares with foals at foot are best presented for their initial reproductive examination towards the end of the foal heat. Maiden and barren mares are best examined just prior to or at the beginning of their season. Mares should be in lean or good body condition but not overweight and in good general health. Vaccinations, dentistry, worming and foot care should be up-to-date.

What is not included?

- Sedatives and muscle relaxants
- Twin reduction after 16 days
- Treatment and investigation of infertility
- Regumate treatment
- Caslicks sutures
- Visits for PD scans done at home
- Livery if staying with us for more than a week
- Additional feed

Pre - breeding assessments

We can carryout a reproductive and fertility assessment of your mare before she is taken to stud. The aim of the assessment is to highlight any fertility problems and to make sure that your mare is in tip top condition for breeding before you make the journey to stud. Any problems highlighted during the assessment can be treated or investigated further.

CEM swabs and blood tests for EVA can be done at this stage*, so that you are not waiting for results when your mare should be getting covered by the stallion.

THE REPRODUCTIVE AND FERTILITY ASSESSMENT INCLUDES:

- Assessment of physical condition - including use of the weigh bridge
- Speculum examination of internal confirmation
- Rectal ultrasound scan of uterus and ovaries
